Subject: HB 2142, land transfers by unified school districts

HB 2142 repeals statutes which authorize the separate land transfers by unified school districts since such transfers have already occurred. Please see attached spread sheet for details on each statute.

If enacted, these amendments will take effect on and after July 1, 2013.
