SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2067 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2067 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2067 would amend current law regarding the appointment of an Assistant Attorney General position to the Kansas Board of Nursing by the Kansas Attorney General. Currently, the language in statute refers to a single Assistant Attorney General position. The bill would allow for the appointment of more than one Assistant Attorney General position to the Board.

The Board of Nursing indicates that the passage of HB 2067 would have no fiscal effect. These positions reside within the Office of the Attorney General.
