**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2129 by House Committee on Elections

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2129 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Beginning with the 2016 general election, HB 2129 would move the date when a county treasurer's term in office would commence from the second Tuesday in October to the second Monday in January following the general election.

The Office of the Secretary of State indicates that HB 2129 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures. A request to provide fiscal effect information has been sent to the Kansas Association of Counties, and we are awaiting a response from them. If the Association provides specific fiscal effect information, a revised fiscal note will be provided.
