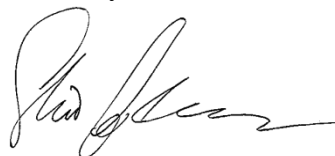
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2146 by House Committee on General Government Budget

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2146 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2146 would repeal the Cancer Drug Repository Program, which allows any person to donate unused cancer drugs to a doctor's office, pharmacy, hospital, or nonprofit clinic to be dispensed to another person.

The Board of Pharmacy indicates that HB 2146 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures because there has been no participation in the program.
