
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2184 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2184 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2184 would require the Secretary of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) to create a Kansas Plan for Comprehensive Treatment of Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease. Mandatory components of the plan would be recommendations for prevention, early detection, treatment, and management of the disease, as well as increasing education about the disease and proper medical management of the condition. The bill would require publication of the plan on the KDHE website.

Passage of HB 2184 would have no fiscal effect.
