SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2186 by House Committee on Legislative Post Audit

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2186 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the Office of the State Treasurer is required to make quarterly distributions to cities and counties from the County Equalization and Adjustment Fund and the Special City and County Highway Fund on January 15, April 15, July 15, and October 15. HB 2186 would allow the State Treasurer an additional 15 days or the remainder of the month to make the distributions.

The Office of the State Treasurer indicates the HB 2186 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
