
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2219 by Representative Garber, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2219 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2219 would exempt private businesses, as defined in the bill, from the provisions of the Kansas Indoor Clean Air Act. To be exempt, a private business would have to employ only persons 21 years of age or older, post notification that no person under 21 would be admitted to the premises, post notification that smoking by persons 21 or older is allowed on the premises, and use square signs for notification that are at least 12 inches in size. The implementation date of the bill would be July 1, 2013.

The League of Kansas Municipalities is unable to estimate how the bill would affect municipalities. Passage of the bill would have no fiscal effect for the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.
