
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2305 by House Committee on Energy and Environment

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2305 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2305 would amend the Kansas Storage Tank Act that is administered by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment to include a requirement for secondary containment when installing new underground storage tank systems.

The passage of HB 2305 would have no fiscal effect on the Kansas Department of Health and Environment because the review of underground storage tank installation permits is similar to other functions currently being performed by the Department.
