
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2436 by House Committee on Vision 2020

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2436 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2436 would allow the Board of Cosmetology to designate inspectors from the Board of Barbering to perform routine inspections in facilities that are licensed by both the Board of Cosmetology and the Board of Barbering.

Passage of HB 2436 itself would have no fiscal effect on the Board of Cosmetology or the Board of Barbering. Currently, both agencies inspect dual-licensed facilities. Enactment of HB 2436 would allow both agencies to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement to allow dual-licensed facilities to be inspected by one agency. Both agencies would realize some savings from having dual-licensed facilities inspected by one agency; however, neither agency can provide an estimate of any potential savings until a Memorandum of Agreement is completed.
