
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2478 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2478 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2478 would allow the venue for prosecution of crimes committed with electronic devices to take place in the county in which the crime occurred, the victim resides, the victim was present at the time of the crime, or property affected by the crime was obtained or was attempted to be obtained.

Enactment of HB 2478 would have no fiscal effect.
