
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2494 by \*

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2494 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2494 would prohibit the issuance of more than one traffic citation during a four-hour period to any motor vehicle found parked, standing, or stopped in the same location.

The Office of Judicial Administration states that passage of HB 2494 could result in fewer parking tickets being written on state grounds, but the fiscal effect would be negligible. The League of Kansas Municipalities cannot estimate what, if any, fiscal effect enactment of HB 2494 would have upon Kansas cities. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2494 is not reflected in *The FY 2015 Governor's Budget Report*.
