
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2527 by House Committee on Veterans, Military and Homeland Security

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2527 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2527 would require all local boards of education to adopt a policy on school safety to protect students, teachers, and other school employees on school property, in school vehicles, or at school-sponsored activities. The policy would include requiring the designated school law enforcement officer, or the school's principal or designee if the school does not have a law enforcement officer, to meet with emergency medical responders and law enforcement agencies of the city or county where the district is located. The purpose of this meeting would be to discuss the school's safety policy.

Enactment of HB 2527 would have no fiscal effect on the state.
