
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2538 by House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2538 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law grants the state ownership and title to all wildlife in the state, both resident and migratory. HB 2538 would amend the law to give landowners the right of first refusal for all antlers of deer illegally hunted on the landowner's property.

According to the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism, passage of HB 2538 would have no fiscal effect.
