
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2541 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2541 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2541 would repeal KSA 65-3425 that defines plastic bottles and containers and their labeling requirements. It would also repeal the penalty for non-compliance.

The Attorney General reports that HB 2541 would have no fiscal effect on its office. There could be an effect on counties, which currently, after repeated violations, receive a civil penalty of \$50 for each violation. The amount of revenue lost by the counties cannot be determined.
