
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2564 by House Committee on Pensions and Benefits

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2564 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, certain school employees who retire from a Kansas Public Employee Retirement System (KPERS) participating employer must wait 30 days before obtaining employment with another KPERS participating employer. HB 2564 would instead require a 60-day wait.

According to KPERS, HB 2564 would have no fiscal effect on the retirement system or agency operations.
