
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2624 by House Committee on Veterans, Military and Homeland Security

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2624 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law requires the Kansas Commission on Veterans Affairs (KCVA) to designate a person at the Kansas Soldiers Home and a person at the Kansas Veterans Home to be in charge of the member funds. Any sums in excess of \$5,000 in these funds are to be deposited with the State Treasurer. HB 2624 would authorize the Executive Director of the KCVA to designate the person at each Home to be responsible for member funds. The bill would remove the requirement that any amount in excess of \$5,000 in these funds be deposited with the State Treasurer. The bill also makes a number of technical corrections to existing law.

The Kansas Commission on Veterans Affairs indicates that passage of HB 2624 would have no fiscal effect.
