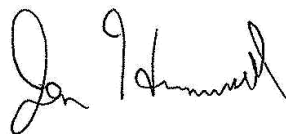
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2684 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2684 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2684 is a trailer bill to HB 2303, enacted earlier in the 2014 Session, which would move the effective date of the original bill from July 1, 2013 to July 1, 2014.

Since the effective date of HB 2303 has already passed, it would require the Department of Revenue to take funding that has already been transferred to the Department for Aging and Disability Services, the Kansas Department of Corrections, and the Kansas Bureau of Investigations and redistribute it based on the revised percentages in the bill. HB 2684 would allow those funds to remain with the agencies and distributions would be made based on the new percentages beginning in FY 2015.
