
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 318 by Senate Committee on Commerce

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 318 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 318 would prohibit any person from applying any pesticide containing 2,4-D or any 2,4-D ester as an active ingredient, either alone or in combination with other ingredients, to any agricultural land, right-of-way, or other easement owned or supervised by such person located in Douglas County between 12:01 a.m. of May 1 of each calendar year through 11:59 p.m. of October 15 of each calendar year. Counties could not choose to be exempt from these provisions.

The Division of the Budget has contacted the Kansas Department of Agriculture regarding the fiscal effect of SB 318; however, no response has been received. If the Division receives information regarding the bill's fiscal effect, a revised fiscal note will be issued.
