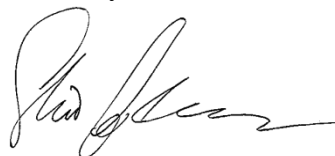
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 40 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 40 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 40 would amend existing law to clarify use of DNA testing in criminal proceedings. The bill would use the term “exonerate” with reference to the results of DNA testing. The bill then defines the term “exonerate.”

According to the Judicial Branch and the Kansas Bureau of Investigation, passage of SB 40 would have no fiscal effect of the either of the agency’s budgets.
