
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 91 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 91 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 91 would establish the Disaster Reimbursement Fund. Monies in the Disaster Reimbursement Fund could be spent for the expenditures of any disaster which was issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster emergency. The fund would not retain its own interest earnings. Rather, the bill directs the earnings to a fund that does not yet exist, the Kansas Emergency Management and Homeland Security Fund.

Enactment of SB 91 would have no fiscal effect on the Adjutant General's Department. Although the bill creates a new fund, it does not provide any revenue source to that fund.
