1 AN ACT concerning the university of Kansas; relating to the medical
2 student loan act; amending K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 76-381 and repealing the
3 existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 76-381 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 76-381. As used in K.S.A. 76-380 through 76-386, and
8 amendments thereto:

9 (a) "Act" means the medical student loan act;

10 (b) "approved postgraduate residency training program" means a
11 residency training program in general pediatrics, general internal
12 medicine, family medicine, family practice, *obstetrics and gynecology*,
13 *general surgery*, emergency medicine or fellowship training in geriatric
14 medicine;

15 (c) "service commitment area" means (1) any community within any
16 county in Kansas other than Douglas, Johnson, Sedgwick, Shawnee or
17 Wyandotte county, (2) any state medical care facility or institution, (3) any
18 medical center operated by the veterans administration of the United
19 States, or (4) the full-time faculty of the university of Kansas school of
20 medicine in family medicine or family practice; or (5) any community
21 within Wyandotte county for purposes of any practice obligation under an
22 agreement entered into by a person who is enrolled for the first time after
23 July 1, 2004, in a course of study leading to the medical degree; and

24 (d) "state medical care facility or institution" includes, but is not
25 limited to, the Kansas state school for the visually handicapped, the
26 Kansas state school for the deaf, any institution under the secretary of
27 social and rehabilitation services, as defined by subsection (b) of K.S.A.
28 76-12a01, and amendments thereto, any institution under the
29 commissioner of juvenile justice as defined by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 38-
30 2302, and amendments thereto, the Kansas soldiers' home, the Kansas
31 veterans' home and any correctional institution under the secretary of
32 corrections, as defined by subsection (d) of K.S.A. 75-5202, and
33 amendments thereto, but shall not include any state educational institution
34 under the state board of regents, as defined by subsection (a) of K.S.A. 76-
35 711, and amendments thereto, except as specifically provided by statute.

36 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 76-381 is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
2 publication in the statute book.
