1 AN ACT concerning school finance; relating to area vocational school
2 fund; relating to local effort as applied to U.S.D. No. 450; amending
3 K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 72-6409 and repealing the existing section; also
4 repealing K.S.A. 72-6422 and 72-8189.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 72-6409 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 72-6409. (a) "General fund" means the fund of a district from
9 which operating expenses are paid and in which is deposited the proceeds
10 from the tax levied under K.S.A. 72-6431, and amendments thereto, all
11 amounts of general state aid under this act, payments under K.S.A. 72-
12 7105a, and amendments thereto, payments of federal funds made available
13 under the provisions of title I of public law 874, except amounts received
14 for assistance in cases of major disaster and amounts received under the
15 low-rent housing program, and such other moneys as are provided by law.

16 (b) "Operating expenses" means the total expenditures and lawful
17 transfers from the general fund of a district during a school year for all
18 purposes, except expenditures for the purposes specified in K.S.A. 72-
19 6430, and amendments thereto.

20 (c) "General fund budget" means the amount budgeted for operating
21 expenses in the general fund of a district.

22 (d) "Budget per pupil" means the general fund budget of a district
23 divided by the enrollment of the district.

24 (e) "Program weighted fund" means and includes the following funds
25 of a district: Vocational education fund, preschool-aged at-risk education
26 fund and bilingual education fund.

27 (f) "Categorical fund" means and includes the following funds of a
28 district: Special education fund, food service fund, driver training fund,
29 adult education fund, adult supplementary education fund, ~~area vocational~~
30 ~~school fund~~, professional development fund, parent education program
31 fund, summer program fund, extraordinary school program fund, and
32 educational excellence grant program fund.

33 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-6422 and 72-8189 and K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 72-6409
34 are hereby repealed.

35 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
36 publication in the statute book.
