1 AN ACT concerning licensing bodies; relating to licensure and military
2 service members; relating to certain distance education courses.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section:

6 (1) "Accreditation" has the meaning ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 2012
7 Supp. 74-32,163, and amendments thereto;

8 (2) "accredited educational institution" means an educational
9 institution that has achieved and maintained accreditation;

10 (3) "applicant" means a person who entered into military service and
11 separated from such military service under conditions other than
12 dishonorable;

13 (4) "community college" means any community college established
14 under the laws of this state;

15 (5) "distance education course" means a course consisting solely or
16 primarily of instruction provided online or in other computer-assisted
17 formats, or by correspondence, audiotape, videotape or other media;

18 (6) "educational institution" means any postsecondary educational
19 institution, private postsecondary educational institution and out-of-state
20 postsecondary educational institution;

21 (7) "institute of technology" or "Washburn institute of technology"
22 means the institute of technology at Washburn university;

23 (8) "licensing body" has the meaning ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 74-
24 146, and amendments thereto;

25 (9) "military service" means the army, navy, marine corps, air force,
26 air or army national guard of any state, coast guard or any branch of the
27 military reserves of the United States;

28 (10) "municipal university" means Washburn university of Topeka or
29 any other municipal university established under the laws of this state;

30 (11) "out-of-state postsecondary educational institution" has the
31 meaning ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 74-32,163, and
32 amendments thereto;

33 (12) "postsecondary educational institution" means any state
34 educational institution, municipal university, community college, technical
35 college and institute of technology, and includes any entity resulting from
36 the consolidation or affiliation of any two or more of such postsecondary

1 educational institutions;

2 (13) "private postsecondary educational institution" has the meaning
3 ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 74-32,163, and amendments thereto;

4 (14) "state educational institution" means any state educational
5 institution, as defined in K.S.A. 76-711, and amendments thereto; and

6 (15) "technical college" means any technical college established
7 under the laws of this state.

8 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a licensing body may
9 authorize any educational requirements for certification or licensure in this
10 state to be waived if an applicant provides satisfactory evidence of
11 completion of a distance education course. To qualify for such a waiver,
12 the distance education course must be:

13 (1) Provided by an accredited educational institution; and

14 (2) substantially equivalent to the educational standards required for
15 certification or licensure in this state.

16 (c) Each licensing body may adopt rules and regulations necessary to
17 implement and carry out the provisions of this section.

18 (d) This section shall not apply to the practice of law or the regulation
19 of attorneys pursuant to K.S.A. 7-103, and amendments thereto.

20 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
21 publication in the statute book.
