AN ACT directing the secretary of health and environment to create a state plan for comprehensive treatment of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) This section shall be know and may be cited as the Kansas plan for comprehensive treatment of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.

- (b) The secretary of health and environment shall create a comprehensive chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) state plan that outlines sustainable solutions for reducing the burden of COPD in Kansas through the coordinated implementation of multiple strategies. These strategies shall include, but not be limited to, recommendations for:
- (1) The prevention and early detection of COPD to reduce the incidence of disease;
- (2) the treatment and management of COPD to ensure that health care providers offer state-of-the-art care, including increased access to nonpharmacologic therapies for COPD; and
- (3) increasing public awareness, patient education and proper medical management of COPD among the general public and those living with COPD.
- (c) The secretary of health and environment shall cause the comprehensive chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) state plan to be published on the department of health and environment's website.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
