

HOUSE BILL No. 2269

1 AN ACT designating a portion of Kansas highway 92 as the John Bowers
2 memorial highway; amending K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 68-1060 and
3 repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. That portion of K-92 highway from the junction of K-
7 92 highway and 94th street in Jefferson county then south on K-92 highway
8 until the northern boundary of the city of McLouth is hereby designated as
9 the John Bowers memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall
10 place highway signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to
11 indicate that the highway is the John Bowers memorial highway, except
12 that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received
13 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for
14 the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to
15 defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The
16 secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations
17 to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

18 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 68-1060 is hereby amended to read as
19 follows: 68-1060. United States highway 24 from the east city limits of
20 Topeka, then east on United States highway 24, to the junction with United
21 States highway 59, then north on United States highway 59, to the junction
22 with K-92 highway, *then in a northeasterly direction on K-92 highway to*
23 *the northern boundary of the city of McLouth*, then in a northeasterly
24 direction *from 94th street in Jefferson county* on K-92 highway to the city
25 of Leavenworth, is hereby designated as the 95th division, the iron men of
26 Metz highway. The secretary of transportation shall place signs along the
27 highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the
28 95th division, the iron men of Metz highway, except that such signs shall
29 not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts
30 and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs
31 and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or
32 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may
33 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing
34 suitable signs.

35 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 68-1060 is hereby repealed.

36 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
