

**Substitute for HOUSE BILL No. 2424**

1 AN ACT concerning roads and highways; designating the Robert G. (Bob)  
2 Bethell interchange; the SGT David Enzbrenner memorial highway; the  
3 Pack St Clair highway; the ancient Indian traders trail; the Harper  
4 county veterans memorial highway; the Bonnie Huy memorial  
5 highway; the Bonnie Sharp *memorial* interchange; amending K.S.A.  
6 2013 Supp. 68-1051 and repealing the existing section.

8 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

9 New Section 1. The junction of K-14 highway and 16th road in Rice  
10 county is hereby designated as the Representative Robert G. (Bob) Bethell  
11 interchange. The secretary of transportation shall place signs along the  
12 highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the junction of K-  
13 14 highway and 16<sup>th</sup> road is the Representative Robert G. (Bob) Bethell  
14 interchange, except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary  
15 has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the  
16 secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the  
17 initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such  
18 signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and  
19 donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

20 New Sec. 2. That portion of K-7 highway from the north city limits of  
21 Atchison, north on K-7 highway to the junction of K-7 with United States  
22 highway 36 is hereby designated as the SGT David Enzbrenner memorial  
23 highway. The secretary of transportation shall place highway signs along  
24 the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is  
25 the SGT David Enzbrenner memorial highway, except that such signs shall  
26 not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts  
27 and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs  
28 and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or  
29 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may  
30 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing  
31 suitable signs.

32 New Sec. 3. The portion of United States highway 75 from the  
33 northern interchange with United States highway 400, then south to the  
34 southern interchange with United States highway 400 is hereby designated  
35 as the Pack St Clair highway. The secretary of transportation shall place  
36 markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that

1 the highway is the Pack St Clair highway, except that such signs shall not  
2 be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and  
3 donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and  
4 an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or  
5 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may  
6 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing  
7 suitable signs.

8 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 68-1051 is hereby amended to read as  
9 follows: 68-1051. The portion of United States highway 75 where it enters  
10 the state on the Kansas-Nebraska border on the north then south to the  
11 junction with K-9, then south from the junction of K-9 with K-62 to the  
12 junction of K-62 with K-16 then east to the junction with United States  
13 highway 75 then south on United States highway 75 to the southern city  
14 limits of Holton, then from the junction of United States highway 75 and  
15 N.W. 46<sup>th</sup> street in Shawnee county then south on United States highway  
16 75 to the southern boundary of Osage county, then from the northern  
17 boundary of Woodson county south on United States highway 75 to  
18 *northern interchange with United States highway 400, then south from the*  
19 *southern interchange with United States highway 400* to the Kansas-  
20 Oklahoma border, is hereby designated the purple heart/combat wounded  
21 veterans highway. The secretary of transportation shall place markers  
22 along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the  
23 highway is the purple heart/combat wounded veterans highway. The  
24 secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations  
25 to aid in obtaining suitable highway signs bearing the proper approved  
26 inscription.

27 New Sec. 5. That portion of K-161 highway from the junction of K-  
28 161 highway with United States highway 36, north on K-161 highway to  
29 the Nebraska state line is hereby designated as the ancient Indian traders  
30 trail. The secretary of transportation shall place highway signs along the  
31 highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the  
32 ancient Indian traders trail, except that such signs shall not be placed until  
33 the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to  
34 reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional  
35 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs  
36 of such signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer  
37 gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

38 New Sec. 6. The portion of United States highway 160 from the  
39 junction of United States highway 160 and K-14 highway, then east to the  
40 eastern boundary of Harper county, then from the southern junction of  
41 United States highway 160 and K-2 highway, then west on United States  
42 highway 160 to the western boundary of Harper county is hereby  
43 designated as the Harper county veterans memorial highway. The secretary

1 of transportation shall place signs along the highway right-of-way at  
2 proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the Harper county veterans  
3 memorial highway, except that such signs shall not be placed until the  
4 secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to  
5 reimburse the secretary for the costs of placing such signs and an  
6 additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or  
7 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may  
8 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing  
9 suitable signs.

10 New Sec. 7. The portion of K-96 highway from the junction with  
11 interstate highway 135 then east to the junction with interstate highway 35  
12 is hereby designated as the Bonnie Huy memorial highway. The secretary  
13 of transportation shall place markers along the highway right-of-way at  
14 proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the Bonnie Huy memorial  
15 highway, except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has  
16 received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the  
17 secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the  
18 initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such  
19 signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and  
20 donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

21 New Sec. 8. The junction of interstate highway 635 and metropolitan  
22 avenue in Wyandotte county is hereby designated as the Bonnie Sharp  
23 *memorial* interchange. The secretary of transportation shall place signs  
24 along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the  
25 junction of interstate highway 635 and metropolitan avenue is the Bonnie  
26 Sharp *memorial* interchange, except that such signs shall not be placed  
27 until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations  
28 to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an  
29 additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or  
30 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may  
31 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing  
32 suitable signs.

33 Sec. 9. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 68-1051 is hereby repealed.

34 Sec. 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
35 publication in the statute book.
