1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending
2 June 30, 2014, and June 30, 2015, for the insurance department.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2014, and June 30,
6 2015, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are
7 hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees,
8 receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby
9 directed or authorized as provided in this act.

10 (b) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
11 K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.

12 (c) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the
13 provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.

15 INSURANCE DEPARTMENT

16 (a) There is appropriation for the above agency from the following
17 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, all
18 moneys now and hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund
19 or funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law
20 shall not exceed the following:

21 Professional employer organization fee fund.....No limit

23 INSURANCE DEPARTMENT

24 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following
25 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, all
26 moneys now and hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund
27 or funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law
28 shall not exceed the following:

29 Professional employer organization fee fund.....No limit

30 (b) On July 1, 2014, or as soon thereafter as moneys are available, the
31 director of accounts and reports shall transfer \$120 from the insurance
32 department service regulation fund in the Kansas insurance department to
33 the maintenance obligations fund of the Kansas department for children
34 and families.

36 publication in the Kansas register.
