

## HOUSE BILL No. 2660

1 AN ACT concerning crimes and punishment; creating the crimes of  
2 abandonment of a human corpse; failing to summon assistance.

3  
4 WHEREAS, The provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be  
5 known and may be cited as Mojo's Law. Now, therefore,

6  
7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. (a) Abandonment of a human corpse is abandoning,  
9 disposing, deserting or leaving a corpse without properly reporting the  
10 location of the human body to a law enforcement agency.

11 (b) Abandonment of a human corpse is a class A person  
12 misdemeanor.

13 (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas  
14 criminal code.

15 Sec. 2. (a) Failing to summon assistance is knowingly failing to  
16 summon assistance if such person:

17 (1) Was present when a crime was committed against another person;

18 (2) knows that the other person has suffered serious bodily harm as a  
19 result of a crime committed against the other person and that the other  
20 person is in need of assistance;

21 (3) can reasonably summon assistance for the person in need without  
22 danger to such person;

23 (4) fails to summon assistance for the person in need; and

24 (5) another person is not summoning or has not summoned assistance  
25 for the person in need of such assistance.

26 (b) Failing to summon assistance is a severity level 7, person felony.

27 (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas  
28 criminal code.

29 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
30 publication in the statute book.
