AN ACT concerning insurance; relating to property damage claims; attorney fees; amending K.S.A. 40-908 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 40-908 is hereby amended to read as follows: 40-908. That in all actions now pending, or hereafter commenced in which judgment is rendered against any insurance company on any policy-given to insure any property in this state against claim for property damage caused by loss—by from fire, tornado, lightning or hail, the court in rendering such judgment shall allow the plaintiff a reasonable sum as—an attorney's—fee attorney fees for services in such action including proceeding upon appeal to be recovered and collected as a part of the costs: Provided, however, except that when a tender is made by such insurance company before the commencement of the action in which judgment is rendered and the amount recovered is not in excess of such tender no such costs shall be allowed.
