5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 35-205 is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-
7 205. (a) The fourth Saturday of September of the present year of our Lord
8 1945, and the fourth Saturday of September of each year thereafter is
9 hereby designated as "**Native** American ~~Indian~~ Day."

10 (b) *The first Wednesday of February of 2014, and the first Wednesday*
11 *of February of each year thereafter is hereby designated as "Native*
12 *American Legislative Day at the Capitol."*

13 **Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 38-2285 is hereby amended to read as**
14 **follows: 38-2285. (a) The board of education of a school district shall**
15 **award a high school diploma to any person requesting a diploma if**
16 **such person: (1) Is at least 17 years of age; (2) is enrolled or resides in**
17 **such school district; (3) is or has been a child in the custody of the**
18 **secretary, or in the custody of a federally recognized Indian tribe in this**
19 **state, at any time on or after such person's 14th birthday; and (4) has**
20 **achieved at least the minimum high school graduation requirements**
21 **adopted by the state board of education.**

22 (b) **This section shall be part of and supplemental to the revised**
23 **Kansas code for care of children.**
