1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas administrative procedure act; service of  
2 order or notice; amending K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 77-531 and repealing the  
3 existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 77-531 is hereby amended to read as  
7 follows: 77-531. Service of an order or notice shall be made upon the party  
8 and the party's attorney of record, if any, by delivering a copy of the order  
9 or notice to the person to be served or by mailing a copy of the order or  
10 notice to the person at the person's last known address, *or by such*  
11 *electronic notice as may be agreed upon by the parties*. Service shall be  
12 presumed if the presiding officer, or a person directed to make service by  
13 the presiding officer, makes a written certificate of service. Delivery of a  
14 copy of an order or notice means handing the order or notice to the person  
15 or leaving the order or notice at the person's principal place of business or  
16 residence with a person of suitable age and discretion who works or  
17 resides therein. Service by mail is complete upon mailing. *Service by*  
18 *electronic notice is complete upon transmission or as otherwise agreed*  
19 *upon by the parties*. Whenever a party has the right or is required to do  
20 some act or take some proceedings within a prescribed period after service  
21 of a notice or order and the notice or order is served by mail, three days  
22 shall be added to the prescribed period.
