1 AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverages; dealing with microbreweries  
2 and manufacturers; amending K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 41-305 and repealing  
3 the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 41-305 is hereby amended to read as  
7 follows: 41-305. (a) A manufacturer's license shall allow the manufacture  
8 and storage of alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverage and the sale of  
9 alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverage to distributors and nonbeverage  
10 users licensed in this state and to such persons outside this state as  
11 permitted by law.

12 (b) A manufacturer's license also shall allow the serving free of  
13 charge on the licensed premises of samples of alcoholic liquor  
14 manufactured by the licensee, provided the premises are located in a  
15 county where the sale of alcoholic liquor is permitted by law in licensed  
16 drinking establishments. Samples shall be served by the licensee, or an  
17 employee or agent thereof. No sample shall be served to an individual who  
18 is a minor. No individual shall remove all or any portion of a sample from  
19 the licensed premises. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to  
20 permit the licensee to sell any alcoholic liquor for consumption on the  
21 premises.

22 (c) A person holding a farm winery license issued pursuant to K.S.A.  
23 41-308a, and amendments thereto, may also be issued a manufacturer's  
24 license; provided, that no alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage  
25 manufactured by such licensee shall be sold by such licensee at its licensed  
26 premises or at any of such licensee's winery outlets.

27 (d) *A person holding a microbrewery license issued pursuant to*  
28 *K.S.A. 41-308b, and amendments thereto, may also be issued a*  
29 *manufacturer's license, except that no alcoholic liquor manufactured by*  
30 *such licensee shall be sold by such licensee at its licensed premises or any*  
31 *such licensee's microbrewery outlets.*

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 41-305 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
34 publication in the statute book.
