Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 72-8809 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-8809. The board of education of any school district which has made a tax 6 levy under K.S.A. 72-8801, and amendments thereto, may at any time 7 after the final levy is certified to the county clerk under any current-8 9 authorization, initiate procedures to renew its authority to make a like an annual tax levy in the amount and upon the conditions and in the manner 10 specified in said-K.S.A. 72-8801, and at five-year intervals thereafter may 11 12 in like manner and on like conditions renew such levy for successive five-13 year periods and amendments thereto. Except as otherwise provided by its 14 terms, any initial resolution adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 72-8801, and 15 amendments thereto, shall remain in full force and effect until such time as a second resolution becomes effective, at which time the initial resolution 16 17 shall become null and void.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-8809 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
