1 AN ACT concerning the use of state appropriated moneys.

3 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

4 Section 1. (a) No portion of any money appropriated by the state  
5 legislature shall be used, other than for normal and recognized executive  
6 and legislative relationships, for publicity or propaganda purposes, for the  
7 preparation, distribution or use of any kit, pamphlet, booklet, publication,  
8 electronic communication, radio, television or video presentation designed  
9 to support or defeat the enactment of legislation before the ***federal***  
10 ***government***, state legislature or a local government legislative body ~~or~~  
11 ~~designed~~ **nor shall any legislative appropriation be used** to support or  
12 defeat any proposed or pending regulation, administrative action, or order  
13 issued by ***the federal government***, any state agency or local government  
14 ***relating to the advocacy or promotion of gun control.***

15 (b) No portion of any appropriation shall be used to pay the salary or  
16 expenses of any grant or contract recipient, or agent acting on behalf of  
17 such recipient, related to any activity designed to influence the enactment  
18 of legislation, an appropriation, a regulation, an administrative action, or  
19 an executive order proposed or pending before the ***federal government***,  
20 Kansas legislature or local government legislative body ***relating to the***  
21 ***advocacy or promotion of gun control.***

22 (c) The prohibitions in subsection (a) and (b) shall include any  
23 activity to advocate or promote any proposed, pending or future federal,  
24 state or local tax increase, or any proposed, pending, or future requirement  
25 or restriction on any legal consumer product, including its sale or  
26 marketing, ~~including, but not limited to,~~ ***relating to*** the advocacy or  
27 promotion of gun control.

28 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
29 publication in the statute book.
