

School Crossing Guards; HB 2420

HB 2420 allows the governing body of any township in Johnson County to appoint and equip volunteers and designated employees as school crossing guards. Formerly, only school districts, nonpublic schools, cities, and counties were authorized to provide school crossing guard services. In addition, the bill authorizes all the named types of jurisdictions to provide training to designated employees as school crossing guards. Prior law authorized such training only for volunteers.

The bill also allows the authorized types of jurisdictions to contract with private providers for school crossing guard services.
