Senate Bill 248

Senate bill 248 repeals K.S.A. 76-12a25. This statute authorizes the chief administrative officer of certain state institutions to establish key deposit funds. These funds are operated to keep track of certain security deposits that state employees pay when they receive keys to the state institutions.

The institutions that are covered by this statute are any institutions under the control of the division of juvenile justice and the department for aging and disability services.

The effective date of this bill is upon publication in the statute book.

This bill passed the senate on a vote of 40-0.
