Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

987654321 Section 1. The duration of regular sessions of the legislature held in

odd-numbered years shall not exceed for calendar days. Such sessions may be extended beyond 60 calendar days by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) to each house.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

publication in the statute book,

sessions of the legislature held in even-numbered years (or appointed) to each house. The duration of regular by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members elected shall not exceed 60 calendar days. Such sessions may be extended beyond 75 calendar days
