Subject: Senate Bill 335

Senate bill number 335 does three things. First, it creates a fund for the Kansas highway patrol. Second, it creates two new surcharges to be imposed at the time a vehicle is registered. Finally, it credits these surcharges to the Kansas highway patrol staffing and training fund and the law enforcement training center fund.

Section 1 creates the Kansas highway patrol staffing and training fund which is to be used for increasing employment and retaining personnel at the Kansas highway patrol.

Section 2 creates the Kansas highway patrol staffing and training surcharge which is \$2 per registration.

Section 3 creates the law enforcement training center surcharge which is \$1.25 per registration.

Section 4 authorizes the Kansas highway patrol staffing and training surcharge and the law enforcement training center surcharge to be remitted to their respective funds.

Section 5 adds language parallel to section 1 which requires the surcharge moneys to be spent only for their specified purposes.

The effective date of this bill is upon publication in the statute book.
