amended as follows:

1 AN ACT concerning agriculture; ~~enacting the alternative crop research act;~~
2 amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5702 and repealing the existing
3 section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 New Section 1. (a) Sections 1 and 2, and amendments thereto, shall
6 be known and may be cited as the alternative crop research act.

7 (b) As used in the alternative crop research act:

8 (1) "Certified seed" means industrial hemp seed that has been
9 certified as having no more tetrahydrocannabinol concentration than that
10 ~~adopted by federal law in the controlled substances act, 21 U.S.C. § 801 et~~
11 ~~seq.~~ delta-9

12 (2) "Department" means the Kansas department of agriculture.

13 (3) "Hemp products" means all products made from industrial hemp,
14 including, but not limited to, cloth, cordage, fiber, food, fuel, paint, paper,
15 particleboard, plastics, seed, seed metal and seed oil for consumption and
16 certified seed for cultivation if the seeds originate from industrial hemp
17 varieties.

18 (4) "Industrial hemp" means all parts and varieties of the plant
19 cannabis sativa, cultivated or possessed by a state educational institution or
20 the department, whether growing or not, that contain a delta-9
21 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of ~~no more than that adopted by~~
22 ~~federal law in the controlled substances act, 21 U.S.C. § 801 et seq.~~ not more than .3% on a dry weight basis

24 (5) "Seed research" means research conducted to develop or recreate
25 better strains of industrial hemp, particularly for the purpose of seed
26 production.

27 (6) "State educational institution" means the university of Kansas,
28 Kansas state university, Wichita state university, Emporia state university,
29 Pittsburg state university and Fort Hays state university.

30 (7) "Tetrahydrocannabinol" or "THC" means the natural or synthetic
31 equivalents of the substances contained in the plant or in the resinous
32 extractives of cannabis or any synthetic substances, compounds, salts or
33 derivatives of the plant or chemicals and their isomers with similar
34 chemical structure and pharmacological activity.

35 New Sec. 2. (a) ~~The department, alone or in coordination with a state~~
36 ~~educational institution, may cultivate industrial hemp grown from certified~~

(1) "Agricultural pilot program" means a pilot
program to study the growth, cultivation or
marketing of industrial hemp in a manner that:
(A) Ensures that only state educational
institutions and the department are used to grow or
cultivate industrial hemp;
(B) requires that sites used for growing or
cultivating industrial hemp in this state be certified
by, and registered with, the department; and
(C) authorizes the department to promulgate rules
and regulations to carry out such pilot program in
accordance with the purposes of section 7606 of
the federal agricultural act of 2014.

Pursuant to section 7606 of the federal agricultural act of 2014, the

establish an agricultural pilot program to

1 seed and promote the research and development of industrial hemp. This
2 research may include:

3 (1) Oversight and analysis of growth of industrial hemp to conduct
4 agronomy research and analysis of required soils, growing conditions and
5 harvest methods relating to the production of various varieties of industrial
6 hemp that may be suitable for various commercial hemp products;

7 (2) seed research on various types of industrial hemp that are best
8 suited to be grown in Kansas, including seed availability, creation of
9 hybrid types, in-the-ground variety trials and seed production;

10 (3) analysis on the economic feasibility of developing an industrial
11 hemp market in various types of industrial hemp that can be grown in
12 Kansas;

13 (4) analysis on the estimated value-added benefits, including
14 environment benefits, that Kansas businesses would reap by having an
15 industrial hemp market of Kansas-grown industrial hemp varieties;

16 (5) a study on the agronomy research conducted worldwide relating
17 to industrial hemp varieties, production and utilization; and

18 (6) a study on the feasibility of attracting federal and private funding
19 for industrial hemp research.

20 (b) The secretary of agriculture shall have the authority to promulgate
21 rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of the alternative crop
22 research act.

23 (c) Nothing in the alternative crop research act shall be construed to
24 authorize any person to violate any federal law.

25 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5702 is hereby amended to read as
26 follows: 21-5702. (a) Prosecutions for crimes committed prior to July 1,
27 2009, shall be governed by the law in effect at the time the crime was
28 committed. For purposes of this section, a crime was committed prior to
29 July 1, 2009, if any element of the crime occurred prior thereto.

30 (b) The prohibitions of this act shall apply unless the conduct
31 prohibited is authorized by the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas, the
32 uniform controlled substances act, *the alternative crop research act* or
33 otherwise authorized by law.

34 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5702 is hereby repealed.

35 Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
36 publication in the statute book.

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(d) The secretary of agriculture shall register and certify no more than 12 acres in this state for sites to grow or cultivate industrial hemp for such agricultural pilot program. Four acres shall be located in the western third of Kansas, four acres shall be located in the Wichita metropolitan area and four acres shall be located in northeast Kansas as such geographic areas are defined by the secretary of agriculture in rules and regulations.
