Note: The HHS poverty guidelines, or percentage multiples of them (such as 125 percent etc.) are used as an eligibility criterion by a number of federal programs including Head Start, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (formerly known as Food Stamps), National School Lunch Program, Low-Income Home Energy Assistance, Children's Health Insurance Program and some parts of the Medicaid program. In general, cash public assistance programs do not use these poverty guidelines in determining eligibility.
