Subject: Continued Funding for Lexia Core 5


To Members of the House Education Committee:

In addition to intervention, this program is also an excellent core instructional resource that helps us ensure that our core instruction is solid and systematic in its approach to vocabulary, phonics, and comprehension.

For the past two years, we have used Lexia Core 5 as our main literacy intervention program in our K-6 buildings. During that time, our data has indicated tremendous improvements in student learning. Below is a chart showing the growth from last school year. As you can see, the program greatly supported students in attaining the skills needed to reach their end of the year benchmark goals.
