## Meeting call to order

Chairman Kahrs opened discussion about <u>HB2543</u>, which was passed out of committee previously, never rose above the line in General Orders, and is back in committee for reconsideration. *Representative Esau moved to add an amendment*. Daniel Yoza of the Office of Revisors explained that the amendment would strike subsection (f) of Section 1. *Representative Campbell seconded*.

Chairman Kahrs distributed an informational brief regarding the amendment which had been prepared by Bryan Caskey, Deputy Assistant to the Secretary of State. (Attachment 1) In response to questions regarding the rules and regulations that would govern compliance with the bill, Chairman Kahrs deferred to Mr. Caskey, who stood to answer. The amendment was passed with two votes in opposition.
