Subject: House Bill 2535

HB 2535 would amend K.S.A. 65-3409 concerning solid and hazardous waste and unlawful acts. The bill would make it an unlawful act for a person to knowingly place household sharps, or other medical household waste containing used or unused sharps, into a recycling container that was intended for collection by a residential hauler to be brought to a recycling center for processing. Any person who violated this requirement would be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
