Dear Chairman Hawkins,

I am pleased to offer a letter of support for Medicaid expansion in Kansas. Saint Luke's South Hospital is a faith-based, not-for-profit community hospital in Overland Park, KS with 125 beds and 600 employees. Since its inception in 1998, Saint Luke's South Hospital has strived to provide the highest quality of healthcare available and our commitment to quality healthcare includes serving those without access to health insurance.

Those Kansans without access to health insurance often go without much needed medical care and such decisions can have a significant financial impact not only on the uninsured but also on the medical provider. Last year Saint Luke's South Hospital provided nearly \$5.8 million in charity care. Saint Luke's South Hospital supports any effort that would reduce the number of uninsured in Kansas. This is an excellent opportunity to craft a Kansas solution that would allow the more than one hundred and forty-four thousand (144,000) Kansas citizens without health insurance the opportunity to obtain low-cost health coverage. Additionally, Medicaid expansion would add an additional \$1.2 million to the Johnson County economy through additional jobs and economic activity.
