Chairman Barker and Committee Members,

Our associations are in support of the amendments to the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Act as proposed in HB2025.

These amendments are simple and serve to clarify the process currently used. The provision for providing reports for investigations conducted by the Commission on Police Officer Standards and Training should help ease the concerns of many chiefs, sheriffs and agency legal staff regarding releasing investigatory documents, often administrative in nature, and personnel documents without any legal justification for doing so.

We urge you to recommend the bill favorably for passage.
