AN ACT concerning certain improvement districts; amending K.S.A. 19-2761 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 19-2761 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-2761.—That—should (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), when a vacancy—oeeur occurs at any time in the office of a director of any improvement district, the remaining directors shall appoint a person from the qualified residents in such district—a—person to hold the office of director until the next election.

(b) When a vacancy occurs in the office of a director of the Peck improvement district located in Sumner and Sedgwick counties, the board of county commissioners of Sumner county shall appoint a resident of Sumner county or Sedgwick county to hold the office of director until the next election.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 19-2761 is hereby repealed.

Balloon Amendments for HB 2165

(b)(2) Once the appointment of a director has been made under paragraph (1), the Sedgwick county board of commissioners shall have 30 days to reject such appointment by a majority vote of the board. If no such action is taken, the appointment shall be deemed approved. If the appointment is rejected, the appointment process shall be repeated until a director is selected.
