Representative Tom Burroughs substituted for Rep. Whipple.

<u>Hearing on: HB2434</u> — <u>Limiting the subtraction modification on business income for tax year</u> 2015 and thereafter; repealing certain addition modifications; treatment of passive income. Chairman Kleeb opened a hearing <u>HB2434</u>.

Scott Wells briefed the Committee on **HB2434**. He stood for questions.

No testimony in support of or neutral to **HB2434** was presented.

Luke Bell presented testimony in opposition to <u>HB2434</u> "which would increase the income tax burden on Kansas small business owners and property owners by excluding rent and other 'passive' types of income from the pass-through exemption". He stood for questions. (<u>Attachment 1</u>)

Eric Stafford presented testimony in opposition to <u>HB2434</u> because the Kansas Chamber of Board of Directors opposes "any attempts to roll back the tax cuts of 2012 & 2013". He stood for questions. (Attachment 2)

Dave Trabert presented testimony in opposition to <u>HB2434</u>, "which would unnecessarily increase income taxes on many employers". He stood for questions. (Attachment 3)

Representative Rhoades made a motion to amend **H sub SB31** by removing item #3. Representative Kelley seconded the motion. After a brief discussion, Representative Rhoades closed on his motion. Motion passed.

Ranking Minority Member Sawyer requested from staff, revised fiscal information affecting **H sub SB31** by the amendment to **H sub SB31**.

In order for staff to prepare the fiscal information requested by Ranking Minority Member Sawyer, Chairman Kleeb recessed the Committee until 2:45 pm.

Chairman Kleeb reconvened the Committee at 2:50 pm.

Chris Courtwright distributed and explained the fiscal note he had prepared at Ranking Minority Member Sawyer's request. (Attachment 8)
