Mr. Chairman and Committee Members

Good afternoon, I am appearing before the Committee today in support of HB 2476. The Riley County Board of County Commissioners asked me to assist in filing a change in state law designed to help counties in collecting delinquent real property taxes.

This bill achieves this by authorizing a county to withhold an amount equal to the unpaid real property taxes for a vendor with a contract for goods or services with the county. The new provision impacts a small percentage of delinquent taxes because it only applies to an instance where a contract with the county exists with a vendor with unpaid property taxes.

The intent of the law is to prevent a business with unpaid or delinquent property taxes from receiving payment for contractual services from a county. If one's business is earning income from tax dollars the expectation is that you pay your property taxes on time.

I ask for your due consideration of this important legislation.
