Bill introductions

Chairman Proehl opened the meeting and called for bill introductions.

Whitney Damron, on behalf of the City of Topeka, requested a bill to delete the requirement a bicycle rider use bicycle paths when they are available. Representative Lusker moved to introduce this bill, seconded by Representative Rooker, the motion carried.

Lisa Kaspar, Director of Motor Vehicle Division, Dept. of Revenue, requested five bills:

- 1) an amendment to comply with the international registration plan
- 2) removes the requirement of those registering vehicles from filing annual reports. The information is now in the system and the reports are not needed
- 3) removes the requirement for vehicle plate registration to be numbered serially in each county. Also because the current system and business practices makes the requirement obsolete
- 4) specified seizure disorders to include other loss of conscience events to provide better clarification
- 5) adds restriction codes to allow compliance with federal motor carrier safety administration

Representative Ryckman moved to introduce the five bills, seconded by Representative Rooker and the motion carried.
