# APPROVAL OF THE COMMITTEE MINUTES

# <u>Hearing on: HB2522 — Clarifying facial imaging practices for drivers' licenses.</u>

He said this bill would position the agency to consider all options with regard to securing our driver's license card, making it as difficult as possible to counterfeit or alter. Chairman Proehl closed the hearing on HB2522 and opened the hearing on HB2527.

The Chairman recognized Wayne Bollig, Deputy Director, Veteran Services. According to Mr. Bollig, this bill was introduced at the request of veterans. He said they are asking that the decals be allowed to be purchased and placed on any of the distinctive military license plates for individuals meeting the qualifications. He asked if there were any opponents again there were none so Chairman Proehl closed the hearing on **HB2527** and opened the hearing on **HB2563**.

## <u>Hearing on: HB2563 — Application fee for restricted motorized bicycle driver's license.</u>

Chairman Proehl recognized Jessica Ross, Manager, Driver Solutions, KS Department of Revenue. According to Ms. Ross, this bill would amend KSA 8-235(d) to add a nonrefundable \$50 application fee to the restricted motorized bicycle driver's license application.
